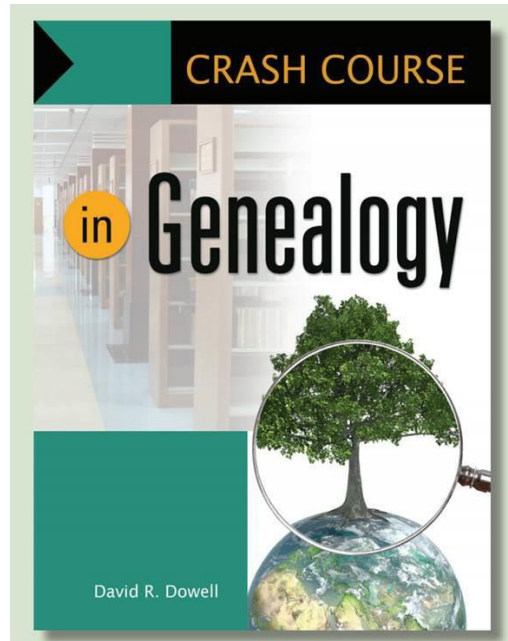


Beginning September 4th at 2:30 PM in the Assembly Room
